It operates by ensuring that products and materials remain in continuous circulation, facilitated through practices such as maintenance, reuse, refurbishment, remanufacture, recycling, and composting.


📿 In Use

Opt for reusable, recycled, or upcycled materials for props and costumes. Consider sharing and renting equipment instead of purchasing new.

Design props and sets with reusability in mind. After production, these items can be repurposed for other projects.

Use **sustainable and recyclable materials** whenever possible. Consider modular sets that can be easily disassembled and reused.
