The number of tax credit certifications for each fiscal year may include productions that were completed in a different fiscal year than what is reported.

The number of tax credit certifications for each fiscal year does not include productions that may have been revoked (if any) in the same fiscal year.

The Production Volume is the total budget under FIBC and the BC spend under PSTC. The budget for FIBC applications may also include the total budget for international treaty co-productions and inter-provincial co-productions.

The budget for VFX only is based on projects that are not filmed in BC and does not represent total VFX activity in the province.
